









# **LOCATION - DISTANCE TO KEY AREAS**







# SEQ TRANSLINK NETWORK MAP










Number of residential building approvals, Scarborough - Newport - Moreton Island SA2 and Moreton Bay (R) LGA




# Value of residential building approvals, Scarborough - Newport - Moreton Island SA2 and Moreton Bay (R) LGA
